- DIVE INTO HISTORY -

Scuba diving in North Carolina is truly an incredible experience. Fed by the warm clear waters of the Gulf Stream, it has incredible visibility and comfortable temperatures making NC Diving always top rated by scuba enthusiasts and dive publications. North Carolina is also referred to as the "Graveyard of the Atlantic." More than 2,000 ships have sunk in these waters and we are teaming up with Captain JT on his boat Under Pressure to go see some! Besides amazing wrecks, there are also Goliath Groupers, Sand Tiger Sharks, Octopus, and more!







Hatteras is some of the greatest diving you will find in the Mid-Atlantic. JT's boat "Under Pressure" is a 6-pack with a cozy covered wheelhouse to protect from the elements. The water is mid-70's to mid-80's with viz typically around 80-100+ feet. There is a wide variety of animal life from mobula rays, turtles, sand tiger sharks, eels, barracuda, oyster toadfish, goliath groupers, octopus, and much more!

After a day of diving, you will head to "Nancy's Fancy" right on the beach. You can spend your free time walking along the shore, or hanging out on the beautiful porch at the house. There are local grocery stores where you can get food and drinks, usually at least one night will be a grill out and we will all have a family style meal. Treat yourself with a relaxing weekend away full of amazing dives!

- Support Marine Protected Areas: Contribute via park fees, donations and volunteerism.
- · Set an Example: Cleanup trash, never intentionally touch, feed or handle marine life, and set examples like these for others to follow.
