
- Boat rides are only about an hour to reach inshore destinations (ask about chartering the boat for offshore)

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- The Miss Mackenzie departs from the **Long Bay Pointe Marina, 2109 West Great Neck Road**. Park in the last parking lot in the back left corner.
- Arrive at least **30 minutes** prior to departure to setup your gear and check in.
- If you plan to spear fish, you **MUST** have your fishing license.
- All rentals must be picked up from LDC **the night before** your dive and rinsed and returned afterwards (we have a hose and dunk tank at the shop-**RENTALS ARE 24 HOURS**)
- **Tanks and weight are not provided**- if you are renting tanks and weight they need to be rented/picked up at the shop.
- Please listen and pay attention to our Captain and crew- their briefings are important, they want you to have a safe and fun trip
- Tickets are non-transferable/non-refundable. Any cancellations must be made more than 48 hours in advance, otherwise they will be forfeited without refund.

WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU:

- Your certification card and DAN Insurance or military ID along with receipt from ticket purchase
- Logbook
- It is important to check all of your gear the night before your dive to make sure everything is working properly. *All dive gear must be in a mesh gear bag- no luggage or plastic boxes.* Below is a brief list of things that are necessary to take for your dive:
 - Mask, snorkel, fins, booties, weights and weight belt (if needed)
 - Wetsuit (minimum of 5mm is suggested) prepare for 60-70 degree waters
 - Hood, vest and gloves are highly suggested and worn by all of our dive professionals
 - 2 full tanks, weight and SMB (safety marker buoy)
 - BC, Regulator, Secondary Air Source (Octo or Air2), computer and/or depth and pressure gauge and timing device



- It is recommended to take motion sickness medication the night before and the morning of your dive (Triptone, Dramamine, Bonine, Ginger tablets, Sea Band, etc) *There are no refunds due to sea sickness.*

- Sunscreen
- Lunch/Drinks and Snacks (you may bring small coolers, and there is usually some room in the boat cooler as well)
- Drybag
- **Tip for crew**- our crew works hard to give you a fun and wonderful diving experience, so please take care of them. Suggested tipping is 10-20% of your trip price. (There are no ATMs at the dock)



SPECIAL NOTE:
We love our ocean and want to keep it and all it's critters clean and safe, so please try to keep plastics at a minimum. Many marine mammals are killed by eating plastics that accidentally go overboard.
